The class X Board Exam results came in the last week of May. Out of the 20 students who appeared , Kum.

Ajmi Asharaf got 94% and bagged many awards. Award from C.B.S.E and many other organizations. Congratulations to Ajmi Asharaf for your brilliant success. The rest of the students also passed with distinctions.

On June 5th the School celebrated World Environment Day. Students brought saplings of plants, and students and teachers planted the saplings in the school premises.

On June 19th , World Reading Day was celebrated. During the students gave speeches regarding the importance of reading. Library books were distributed to the students to read and write the review of the book they read and submit to the class teachers

On June 24th International Yoga Day was celebrated. Students brought their yoga mats and performed yoga during the morning Assembly.

In August Kerala was hit by tragic floods. So onam festival could not be celebrated. Students and teachers collected money, eatables, bed sheets, rice and other essential commodities and distributed to the flood victims who were refugees in the Govt. School.

The Manager, Sri. Prince P George, took the school bus to take food packets and other essential commodities organized by the Panchayath members to the victims of the flood affected areas such as Chengannur, Ranni, Koni and other areas.

The service went on every alternate day for 5 days in Onam Vacation.

On Sept 5th , Teachers Day was grandly celebrated. X Class students became teachers and took classes and made the teachers free that day. They understood the pains the teachers were taking for them and they really appreciated our teachers.

On Nov 14th Children's Day was celebrated. In the morning Assembly some students were dressed as Jawaharlal Nehru with a rose on their pockets and delivered speeches on Jawaharlal Nehru. Thereafter all the students had Drawing & Coloring contest, and in the afternoon, Fancy Dress Competition. Many students took part in the competition and bagged prizes.

Era exam was conducted on October 24th. Angel Reji of class V won the state level Trophy and cash prize of

Rs.1500. Many other students won the cash prizes, medals and trophies.

In the Inter School Quiz Contest organized by the Panchayath our school students participated and stood 4th.

Arts Days were conducted on November 23rd and 24th. There were competitions in, singing classical songs, light music, film songs, mappilapattu, folk songs, recitation and poem writing, essay writing, story writing in all three languages - English, Malayalam and Hindi were conducted. All the students could participate in all the competitions. Many students participated and bagged trophies and certificates.

Annual sports day were conducted on 3rd and 4th December. Running, High jump, Long jump, Javelin throw and Discus throw and group games were held.

Inter-hours matches in cricket, Foot ball, Throw ball, and Volley Ball were held for both boys and girls. They bagged many Trophies and Certificates. In Y.M.C.A drawing competition Ganesh Nair of class V and Alhana Siddique of L.K.G class bagged the prizes.

Rubella Vaccine was given to the students as per the direction of Health Office of Kulathupuzha.

An Officer of Health Department had come to school and took class for the Senior Students (VII to X) regarding the importance of health and hygiene.

Christmas was grandly celebrated by making crib and X'mas tree, and exchanging X'mas gifts to Christmas friends. Most of the children were dressed in red and wore the Santa caps. One boy acted as Santa Claus. The children sang X'mas songs and danced to the dream beats of senior students. Everybody enjoyed, students and teachers as well. Senior Students went for the excursion to Wonderla , Kochi and Lulu Mall, and junior students went to Happy Land, Thiruvananthapuram. All children enjoyed very well.

So far we have finished Ist Unit Test, P.T- I, P.T- II, and Half-Yearly Exam. P.T- III Exam will start from 10th January.

After that, X class students will answer twenty-five Revision Exams and after that Model Exam. A grand

Farewell will be given to class X students after their Model Exam.

Parents Meetings were held every month and also after every Exam. Every child's academic and behavioural problems were solved. Manager Sri. Prince.P.George took extra care in handling the students' needs.

A counsellor named Sri. Raju visited every week and counselled the students who had behavioral problems. He also counselled the parents of such students.

The students were shown Smart-Class [Next Education] after teaching every chapter, from K.G to X. Even Baiju's Apps in the computer was shown to the students of classes IX, X by The Manager Sri. Prince.P.George, whenever he was taking Science Classes to the students of classes IX & X.
